

SUBJECT: NRO Forecast for January 1966


The NRO forecast for January 1966 was approved by telephonic vote on 31 December 1965. The Secretary of Defense and Mr. Bundy later stood down IDEALIST TACKLE missions over South China until further notice so as to eliminate possible conflict with the current peace negotiation climate.
