SUBJECT: Mutual Balanced Force Reductions

As you are aware, there is considerable internal and international discussion at this time on Mutual Balanced Force Reduction between NATO and Warsaw Pact countries. For the past several months, there has been some degree of interagency activity in formulating a U.S. position. Of interest to our office is the verification aspect of a potential agreement. I have been in contact with Colonel Howard Moore, JCS (SAAC), who is the primary action officer in DOD. He and Lt Col James Peterson, DIA, have agreed to meet with us on Thursday, July 29, at 1400 to informally bring us up to date on the status of MBFR. I have taken the liberty of setting aside 1400-1500 on your calendars on that day in order that you may be present at the briefing.
